

At the summit is a vast crater seven and a half miles long by two and a half miles wide, and 3,000 feet deep. Marvel at the crater's eerie landscape of cinder cones and ancient lava formations. This evening join your fellow travelers for a Farewell Dinner and say Aloha to the Islands as you enjoy a Hawaiian Luau, a fun filled cultural event featuring traditional food, dancing and music.
